DATE: Saturday 23 or Sunday 24 March, 2024—see schedule over page

VENUE: Melbourne Sports Centres (MSC) Parkville, previously called State Netball Hockey Centre

ADDRESS: 10 Brens Drive, Parkville—near the zoo, off Elliott Ave.

ENTRANCE: Entry Door A (rear of building)—once inside, head upstairs COURT NAME: Parkville Arena

## By Car -

It is 3 kilometres from CBD and easily accessible via Citylink. Head for The Zoo and Brens Drive is off Elliott Ave **By Tram** -

Route 58 (West Coburg to Domain Interchange) - Stop 24

By Train -

Take the Upfield line and arrive at Royal Park Station.

**PARKING AT VENUE:** There are 300 paved car parking spaces with an additional 250 car parking spaces available in the overflow areas adjacent.

**BOOKING & PAYING FOR GRADINGS:** You'll know when you're ready to grade by logging into your Member Login via gohalls.com.au. Once logged in, please click on your member's name, scroll down the Client Details page and click on the **Student Skill Assessment**. When the '**Grading Ready**' button is highlighted, you'll know it is time to book and pay for your grading. Just follow the prompts.

This integrated process is dependent on class attendance as well as technique. It should also coincide with students earning a green/gold tape on their belts in class.

Before **Wednesday 20 March** ALL STUDENTS <u>must</u> take to their Hall's Taekwondo Instructor their Grading Book for Term Assessment. Grading fees are \$78 for all belts except Black Belts who have a different pricing structure. New belts will be presented on Grading Day.

Full priced Grading fees can be paid on-line through the booking process <a href="https://hallstaekwondo.com.au">hallstaekwondo.com.au</a> Family discounts can only be applied in person at Centres.

Family discounts to grading fees apply at 5% for each of two family members, 10% for each of 3 and 15% for each of 4 or more family members. Grading books must be taken to the Grading.

Please organise your Grading admin well in advance to reduce grading day nerves and stress. Grading payments made on the day of the grading will incur a \$10 administration 'late fee'.

## SPECTATORS AT MELBOURNE SPORTS CENTRE (MSC):

MSC has a no cash policy and Intix Spectator tickets need to be purchased in advance. Adult 18+: \$13

Child 17 yrs & under: FREE (but still requires ticketing)

Tickets are valid for entry and re-entry over both grading days. Pay for one day only.
