

GRADING details

DATE: Saturday 16 or Sunday 17 September, 2023—see schedule over page

VENUE: Melbourne Sports Centres (MSC) Parkville, previously called State Netball Hockey Centre

ADDRESS: 10 Brens Drive, Parkville—near the zoo, off Elliott Ave.

ENTRANCE: Entry Door A (rear of building)—once inside, head upstairs **COURT NAME:** Parkville Arena

By Car -

It is 3 kilometres from CBD and easily accessible via Citylink. Head for The Zoo and Brens Drive is off Elliott Ave

By Tram -

Route 58 (West Coburg to Domain Interchange) – Stop 24

By Train -

Take the Upfield line and arrive at Royal Park station.

PARKING AT VENUE : There are 300 paved car parking spaces with an additional 250 car parking spaces available in the overflow areas adjacent.

GRADING FEES: As soon as students have a minimum 5 tapes on their belt or 5 stars on their hallstaekwondo.com.au profile page, they qualify to pay and register for their grading. Simply **scan the QR Code** on reverse page to pay online. Before **Wednesday 13 September** ALL STUDENTS must take to Hall's Taekwondo receptionist or Head Instructor their Grading Book and fill in a grading attendance form at the desk. Grading fees are \$78 for all belts except Black Belts who have a different pricing structure. Grading fees cover the examination cost, certificate updates and new colour belts that will be presented on the day.

Full priced Grading fees can be paid on-line by scanning QR Code over page or visit hallstaekwondo.com.au/shop Family discounts can only be applied in person at Centres.

Family discounts to grading fees apply at 5% for each of two family members, 10% for each of 3 and 15% for each of 4 or more family members. Grading registration and payment will be receipted in grading book which will be returned to students prior to grading. Grading books must be taken to the Grading.

The grading attendance form clearly identifies the student's age and belt level to ensure good administrative planning and court layout. It is essential this is organised prior to grading day, as outlined above. Grading payments made on the day of the grading will incur a \$10 administration 'late fee'.

SPECTATORS:

A \$13 spectator ticket applies to all Adults 18+. Children 17yrs and under will be admitted free. Scan QR code opposite for spectator tickets in advance. They are valid for entry and re-entry over both grading days. Pay for one day only.
